Travel Information

By train

If you come to Zaragoza by train or bus you will reach the [Zaragoza Delicias Intermodal](#) station, which is located within the city. The station is well-communicated with both the different neighborhoods and the airport.

Barcelona and Madrid provide a good connection through the high-speed train (AVE). The Barcelona train station is called Barcelona-Sants and the Madrid train station is called Madrid-Atocha. If you arrive by plane to Madrid or Barcelona you need to arrange transportation from the airport to the train station:

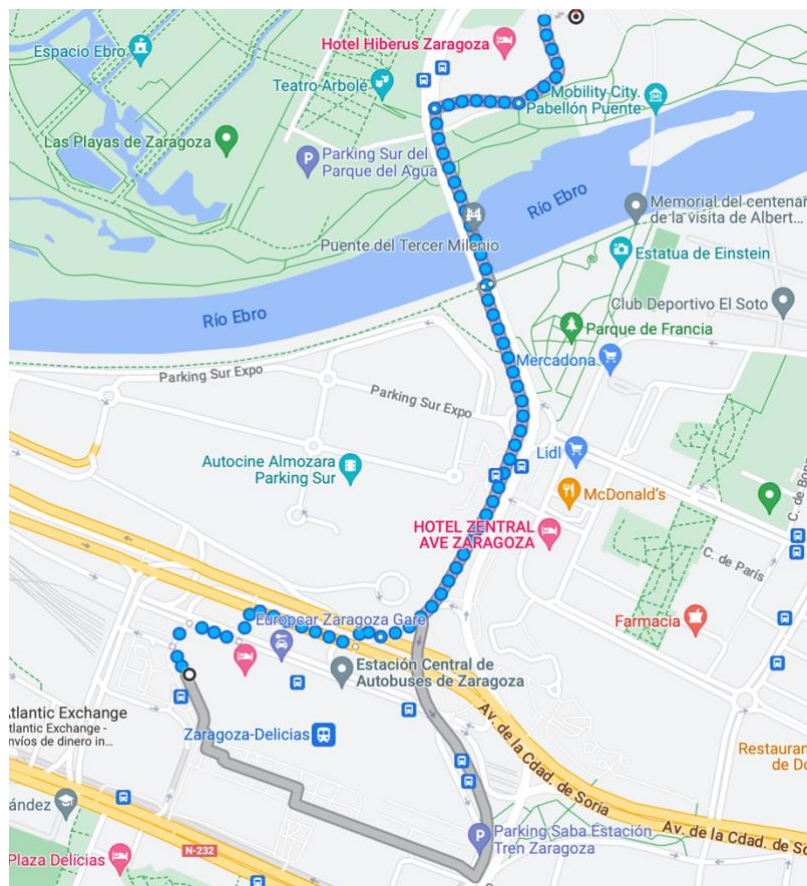


The Zaragoza Delicias Intermodal Station houses a hotel, a business center, shopping centers, and a variety of services for travelers. Zaragoza belongs to the AVE Cities Network.

By car

Zaragoza is located at an interesting crossroads, meaning that you can access it via the motorways from Madrid, Huesca, Teruel, and Valencia, or the national highways from Barcelona, Bilbao, and Pamplona.

Once you reach the outskirts, the Z-40 and Z-30 ring roads allow easy access to the city's various neighborhoods. The conference venue is located in the Expo area, which is situated within the Actur neighborhood.

Entering Zaragoza from Europe is aided by the Somport tunnel which links the city with France and provides direct access into the heart of the country.

By bus

Buses entering Zaragoza arrive at the [Zaragoza Delicias Intermodal](#) station, which is located within the city. The station is well-communicated with both the different neighborhoods and the airport.

By plane

Located around 10 km away from the city, a range of airlines operate from the airport, offering services to Madrid, Palma de Mallorca, Tenerife, Málaga, Sevilla, Lanzarote, Paris, London, Frankfurt, Milan Bergamo, Rome, Bologna, Alicante, Brussels, Bucharest, Cluj-Napoca, and La Coruña.

HOW TO GET HERE

The Airport is connected to the city via bus, taxi, and rental cars.

AIRPORT BUS

There is a bus service between the airport and the city centre. The journey takes from 20 to 30 minutes, with a cost of €1.70 for a single one-way ticket.

Operating hours are from:

- Mondays to Saturdays, from Zaragoza, between 5:30am and 10:30pm, and from the airport, between 6:15am and 11:15pm, buses depart every half an hour.
- On Sundays, buses depart every hour.

Registration and Information Desk

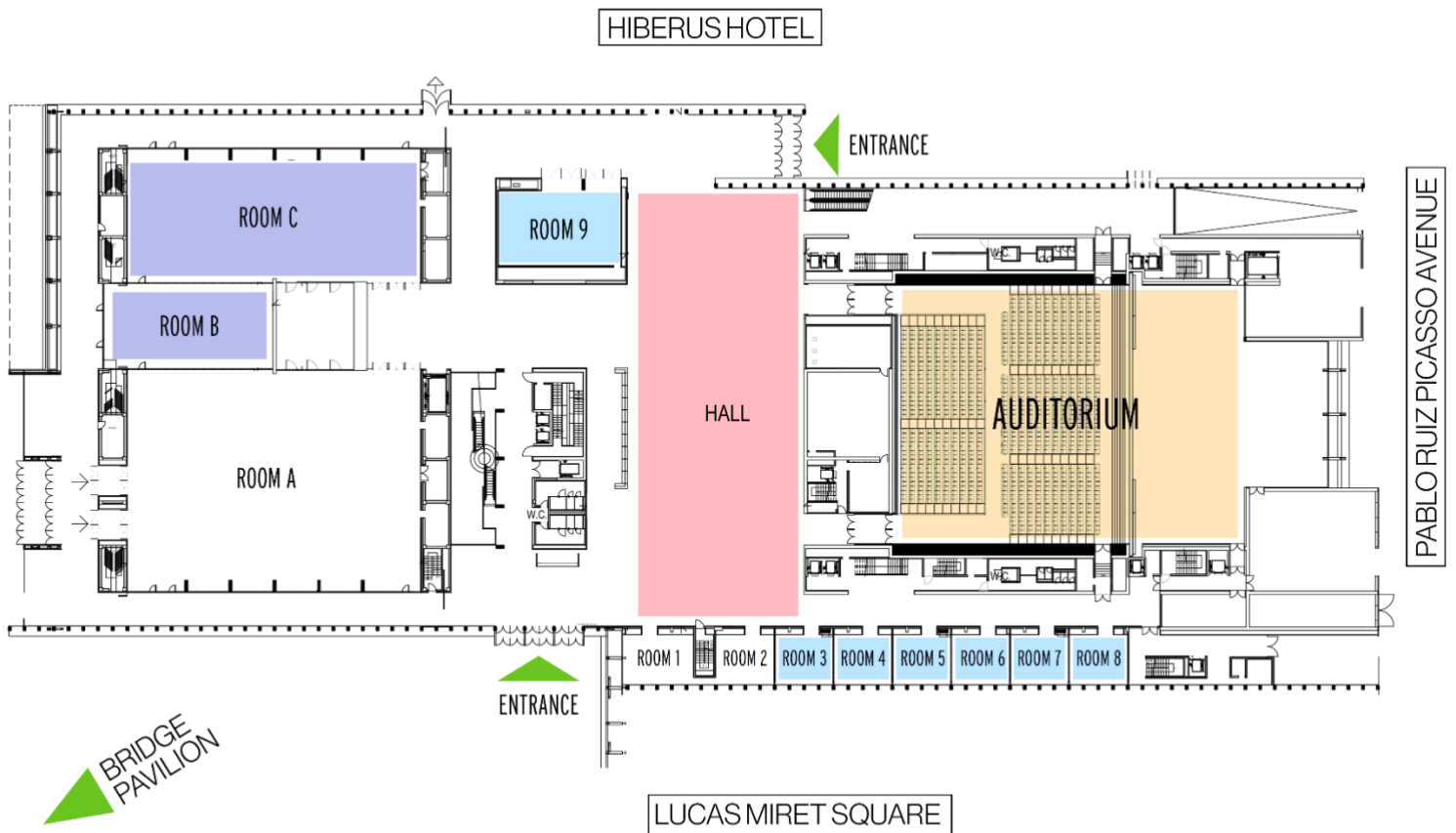

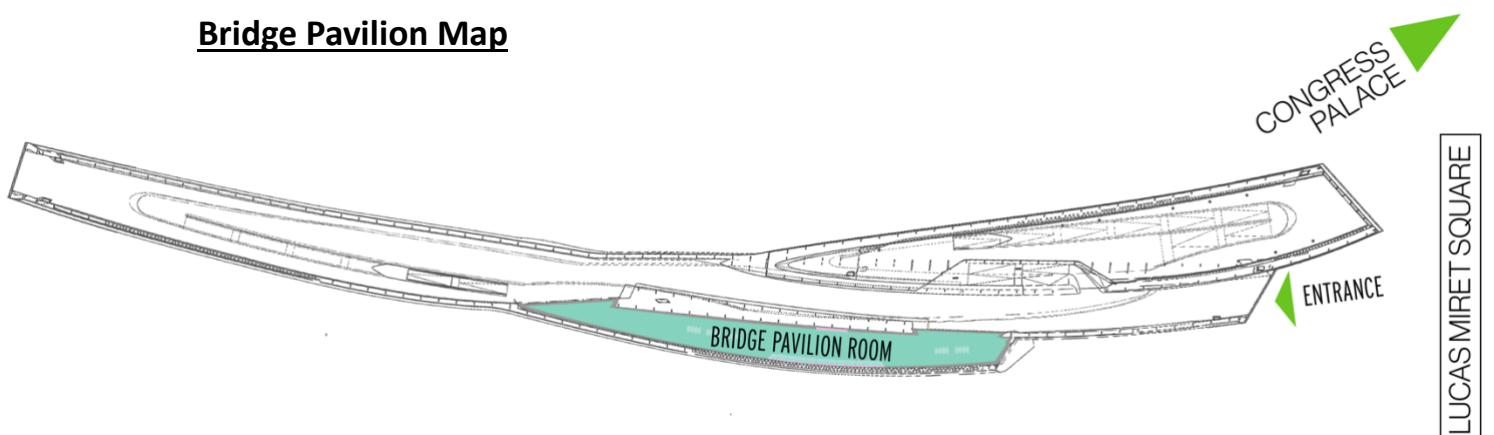
Conference Venue Map

Conference party (Wednesday, 17:30)

- For the conference party, we will first take a visit to the Aljafería Palace (C. de los Diputados, s/n, 50003 Zaragoza, Spain), then we will go to Alquería estate (C. de la Autovía de Logroño, Km. 10.5, 50180 Utebo, Zaragoza, Spain).
- To that extent, we will take a bus to Aljafería at 17:30 (departure from the Congress Palace). Please be in time to catch the bus to Aljafería (if you miss it, you will need to find your own way to the event, which is about 20 minutes walking distance from the conference venue). We will have a guided tour of the Aljafería Palace, which will last about 45 minutes. After that, we will take another bus to the Alquería estate. On our way back, we will make two stops at Hiberus Hotel and at Paseo María Agustín 7.
- The party is only open to registered attendees, make sure you bring your badge along to get in!

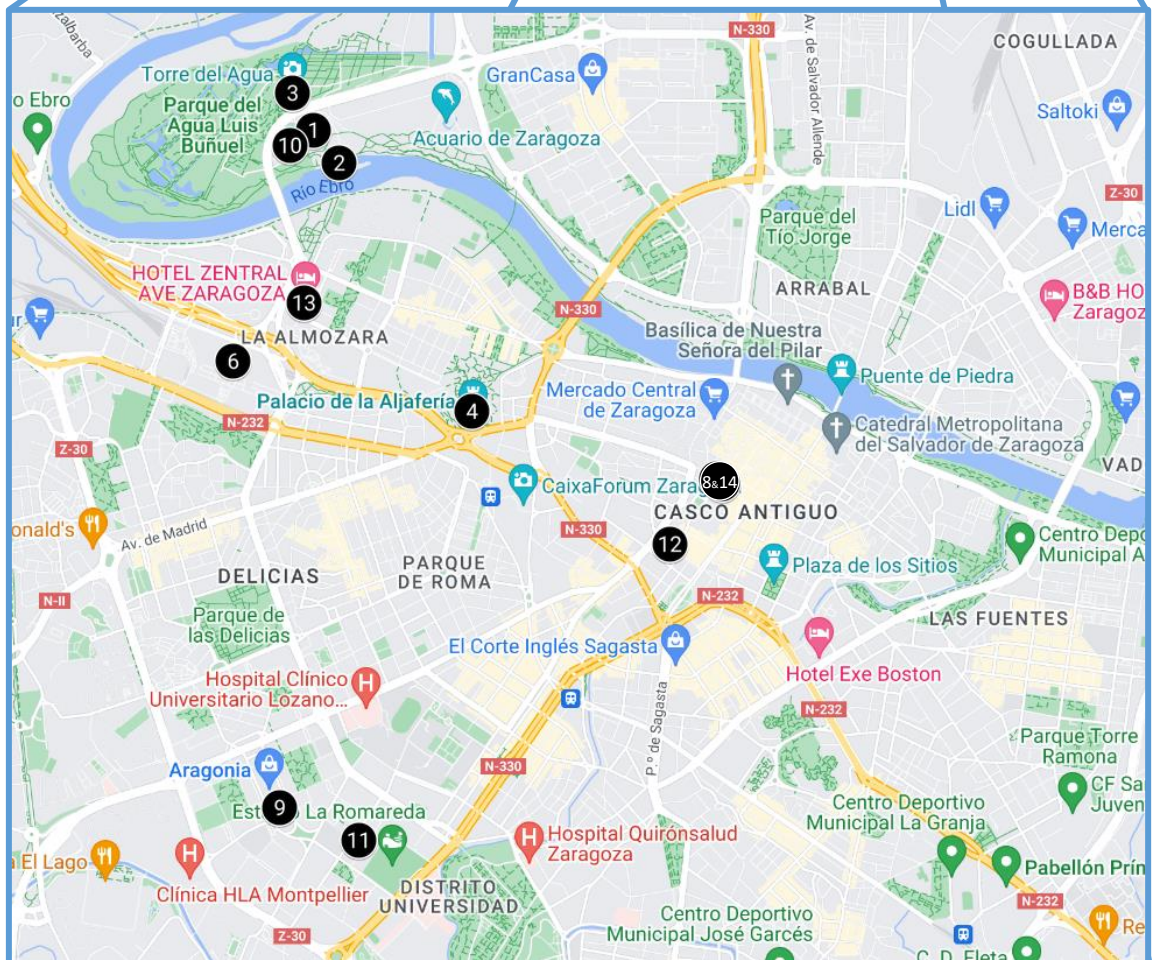
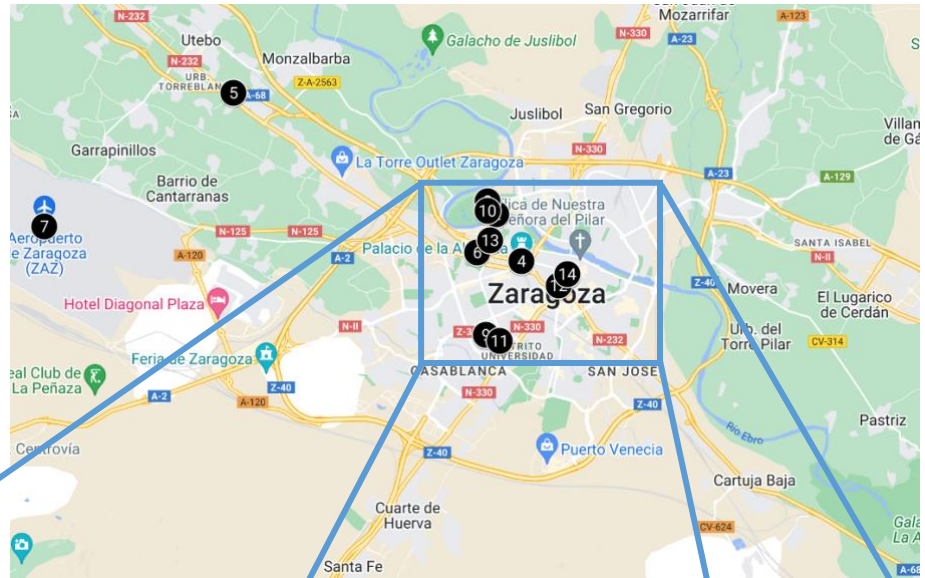
